

# PATHWAY LAWN BOWLS

## EXPLORE

Take the first step and experience Lawn Bowls at your local bowling club. Contact Parafed Waikato for a list of inclusive clubs in your area and go along for a roll up.

## SOCIAL PARTICIPATION

Participate at a social level at your club. Bowling clubs organise their own social tournaments and you can go along and have fun.

## COMPETITIVE PARTICIPATION

Take your bowling seriously and compete at the Parafed Waikato ACTIV8 Lawn Bowls tournament and any of Bowls New Zealand's sanctioned tournaments (e.g New Zealand Disabled Bowls National Championships and NZ Open).

## LEARN

Learn to play Lawn Bowls at your local inclusive bowling club. Bowls NZ have a No Exceptions Policy in place but some clubs may be restrictive on what kind of wheelchair can be taken on to the green.

## PERFORM

Regularly compete in Bowls New Zealand's sanctioned tournaments and display commitment to training and improvement. Compete in the NZ Open and get noticed by the NZ coach and selectors. Take part in the NZDB Trials and have the opportunity to be selected for higher honours.

## EXCEL

Train with the Black Jacks and earn the opportunity to represent New Zealand in International Lawn Bowls. Compete as part of the NZ team in events such as Commonwealth Games and World Disabled Bowls Championships.
